Received a letter from Ontario Municipal Social Services Association (OMSSA) in support of the resolution. OMSSA will bring the resolution forward for endorsement at its May 15 AGM.

February 19, 2002

Received a reply from the Chief MOH on behalf of the Health Minister indicating there are no plans to expand the CINOT dental program to include seniors and has referred the resolution to the Seniors' Secretariat.

December 5, 2001

The Chief MOH has copied on a letter he wrote to the ADM, Ontario Seniors' Secretariat at the Ministry of Citizenship for response to our resolution.

November 30, 2001

Received a response from AMO that its policy team will explore the matter further and that the resolution will be forwarded to the AMO Community, the Social Services Task Force and the Public Health Committee for their consideration.
