Honourable Sir, please be advised the Health & Social Services Committee of Regional Council considered the above matter and at a meeting held on March 11, 2009 Council adopted the following recommendations of the Committee:

"a) THAT the following recommendations of the Middlesex-London Board of Health dated January 15, 2009, with respect to carbon monoxide detectors, be endorsed:

'(THAT the Middlesex-London Board of Health) Endorse the intent of the Private Member's Bill 143 know as The Hawkins Gignac Act (Carbon Monoxide Detectors), 2008 on the understanding that clarification to specific requirements will be addressed as the proposed legislation goes forward; and further;

(THAT the Middlesex-London Board of Health) Send a letter of endorsement to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care; and further

(THAT the Middlesex-London Board of Health) Seek support for this endorsement from other Boards of Health and from the Association of Local Public Health Agencies.'; and

b) THAT the Premier of Ontario, Ministers of Community Safety and Correctional Services, Health and Long-Term Care, Health Promotion, and Municipal Affairs and Housing, Ernie Hardeman, MPP, Durham's MPPs, Acting Chief Medical Officer of Health, aPHa, and all Ontario Boards of Health be so advised."
