Jennifer McLeod is a Zone Nursing Officer, with First Nations & Inuit Health, Health Canada, for the Moose Factory Zone. Through the Moose Factory Zone office, Jennifer is responsible for the delivery of community health nursing services in Moose Factory, Fort Albany, Kashechewan, Attawapiskat and Peawanuck on the west coast of James and Hudson's Bay. As all of these communities are remote and isolated, community health nursing services include both primary care in a nursing station setting, in Kashechewan and Peawanuck, and the delivery of public health programs to a population of 11,000 First Nations people in all five communities.

Jennifer is a registered nurse with the College of Nurses of Ontario and a member of the Registered Nurses Association of Ontario. She graduated with a Bachelor of Nursing Science from Queen's University and a Masters of Education from Nipissing University. Her nursing career has included extensive experience in First Nations health, nursing management, acute care hospital nursing, staff education, infection control, provincial public health and long term care.

Jennifer is also a member of the senior management team at Weeneebayko Health Ahtuskaywin in Moose Factory.
