

**Lynne Slotek** is the CEO of the Institute of Wellbeing and the National Project Director of the Canadian Index of Wellbeing (CIW). Ms. Slotek is also a member of the Canadian Sustainability Indicators Advisory Committee, International Institute for Sustainable Development.

Prior to joining the Atkinson Foundation to manage the Canadian Index of Wellbeing project in 2003, Ms. Slotek held a number of senior executive positions including Executive Director of the Children's Aid Foundation, Sistering and the John Howard Society of Toronto.
